Subject: MTC Membership Committee July Report

Kudos to Jeffrey Kamys whose successful Memorial Day Tournament brought in 17 new members ie 13 new memberships.

We welcomed Mercita Oliva to our meeting. Mercita is a new member and the USTA Norcal Marin County area Coordinator. She contributed greatly to our discussions and will join us next month.

Peggy Hodel, Office Manager and Joan Corbett, Membership Coordinator, also join us. Both were very helpful in guiding our discussion of Guest Policy Review and Proposed Changes to the Board.

Guest Policy Recommended Changes to the Board:

- 1. Guest Policy applies to all guests.
- 2. Junior Members holding Junior Memberships may have a free guest once a week up to four in a month. Junior Guests otherwise will pay guest fees as described in the Guest Policy.
- 3. There will no longer be free guest days or free guest times.
- 4. USTA Flex League and Playtime Marin League may reserve one court(preferably court #4) per day between 1-4 pm on weekdays only. There may be three guests on the court all of whom pay guest fees.
- 5. 4.5 Rated Players (men and women) will continue to pay guest fees and abide by the current Guest Policy.

MTC 4.5 players represent 14% of the clubs members. The women's 18+ Team had a difficult season with 9 of the 25 eligible players injured or not playing USAT anymore. Eight 4.0 players rostered for this team contributing no doubles wins. There were 4 nonmembers at the beginning of the season, one of which is a new member now.

NEW Member Sponsor Recognition Recommended Change to the Board:

The MC recommends to the Board, that every member who sponsors a new member(s) will receive a \$50 credit on their monthly bill for each membership.

2017 New Members To Date:

22 New Memberships in 2017 year to date, 29 new members. 12 are single, 7 are family, 3 are Junior/Associates. Most are men, most are 3.0 - 4.0 players. most are age 40+, most are reciprocal memberships, five are returning members. All new men have been introduced to Jack and Vic and are included in their email invitations to weekly play. 13 are rostered on MTC USTA mixed and 55+ teams. Details are attached.

Resignations/Conversions year to date:

Eight Memberships have been conversions or resignations. More discussion on this topic next month.
