As you may or may not know, MTC has participated in the new Wilson sponsored RecycleBalls program since April. Since then we have kept 8600 used tennis balls out of our landfill! The program nationwide has recycled 2.5 million tennis balls. Check out the video What happens to a donated used ball? RecyleBalls is a non-profit that receives generous support from Wilson but it stills costs approximately \$600 per facility per year to fund the QUICKSHIP program. MTC is receiving a 2019 tax deduction benefit of \$3440 which is about .40 per ball. Since MTC is already a non-profit, we do not benefit financially from the donation. We are seeking an individual, team, business or organization to sponsor the RecycleBalls program at MTC. There is only ONE program

sponsorship opportunity available per facility per year. The cost is \$600 for the year and is billed at \$50 per month for 12 months.
